Students can purchase the \$15+ enrollment codes from the website at www.elinstruction.com. Each student in a class using the device needs a clicker (pad), which s/he purchases like a textbook through The Law Bookstore. However, if a student has two "clicker classes," s/he only needs one clicker. The situation is analogous to taking two classes which each require an identical text.</p>
