SUBJECT: Tuition and Fee Rates for the 2017-2018 Academic Year

Western State College of Law at Argosy University (Western State) has set the tuition rates for the academic year commencing with the fall 2017 semester.

- Tuition for students enrolling full-time (12 - 16 units) will be \$21,430 per semester. Full-time students enrolling in an overload and taking more than 16 units per semester will be charged the full-time tuition of \$21,430 per semester and an additional \$1,433 for each unit above 16 taken during the semester.
- Tuition for students enrolling part-time (1 - 10 units) will be \$14,330 per semester. Part-time students enrolling in an overload and taking an 11th unit during the semester will be charged the part-time tuition of \$14,330 per semester plus \$1,433 for the additional unit taken during the semester. Students in their final fall or spring semester may petition to pay only the “per-unit” rate of \$1,433 per unit taken if enrolled in less than 8 units in order to complete their unit requirements.
- The tuition rate for summer 2018 courses will be \$1,433 per unit.

In addition each student will be assessed the following non-refundable fees each semester:

This is a pass-through fee that is paid to the provider on the student's behalf. Student Health Insurance costs are determined by the carrier and are communicated to students each year. More information on Student Health Insurance and the waiver process is emailed to students in late June/early July.

Student Health Insurance Disclaimer: The rates have not been approved by the California Department of Insurance (CDI), and are subject to change based on CDI review. Information related to the CDI approval and the student health insurance waiver option will be emailed to students.

*** students who first sign their enrollment agreement on or after 9/15/14 are required to pay this one time fee of 50¢ per \$1,000 of estimated institutional charges for the program, rounded to nearest dollar. The State of California created the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic losses suffered by students in educational programs who are California residents, or are enrolled in a residency programs attending certain schools regulated by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education. Students who begin enrollment at Western State in spring 2015 and after should refer to their copy of their Enrollment Agreement for more information. The STRF rate is subject to change based upon the balance in the STRF account. Statute requires the Bureau begin collecting if the balance falls below \$20 million (\$20,000,000) and caps the account at \$25 million (\$25,000,000). Please see the office of admissions for questions regarding the assessment of the STRF fee. Because this institution participates in the STRF, students who are otherwise eligible are protected by STRF regardless of whether the fee is assessed.*
